The Virginia Beach section offers scholarships to African American students or students of African-descent that are High School Seniors who have excelled academically and plan to pursue a college degree during the 2020-2021 school year.

SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Must be an African American or African-descent high school senior attending a public or private high school in Virginia Beach, Virginia.
- Students must submit an **official** High School Transcript.
- Must have a GPA of at least 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
- Must be planning to apply to an accredited institution of postsecondary education for the 2020-2021 academic year.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PARTICIPANTS WILL BE SELECTED BASED ON THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA

- Completed scholarship application, postmarked by Friday, March 20, 2020 (Grammatically correct and legible).
- Minimal GPA of 2.5 (on a 4.0 scale).
- Completed High School Senior.
- Official High School Transcript.
- Essay of 300-350 words (doubled spaced, 12 pt. font TIFF).
- Photo (Please attach a recent photograph of yourself to this application).
